# Memorial Plaque

Granite marker inscribed with the name and birth and death dates of loved one interred or inurned elsewhere.

## Columbarium

A freestanding wall with niches for placing urns containing cremation ashes.

### Niche

Recessed compartment for placing urns containing cremation ashes, with inscribed granite marker.

# **Companion Niche**


A shared space for two cremated remains of spouses.

A shared space for two cremated remains, that can be named or unnamed at time of reservation or death.
