

APPLYING TO THE SCHOLARSHIP OF HOPE

WHO IS ELIGIBLE: Any LCHope member who is at time of application a high school senior through the junior level of any post-secondary education or vocational training at an accredited institution, for a maximum of 4 years of eligibility for undergraduate studies.

Christian ministry students may continue to apply for scholarships for post-graduate work for a maximum of an additional 4 years.

HOW TO APPLY: Applications are available as of June 1 at www.lchope.org/scholarshipofhope.

Applicants can fill out the online application or print the pdf and mail the application to the church office.

Applications are due to the church office by July 1.
