WEDDING INFORMATION FOR LUTHERAN CHURCH OF HOPE

Lutheran Church of Hope welcomes you, your family and friends to celebrate your wedding day with us.

The entire facility of LCHope is a sacred place. It was built to be a space where people gather to celebrate and mark life passages. We expect that this place will be used and treated with reverence. There is no smoking, tobacco, or alcohol allowed on our entire campus for weddings.

A few notes about weddings at LCHope:

- A wedding coordinator at LCHope will meet with you prior to your wedding day and will be there to assist you with logistics and the liturgy on the day of your wedding.
- There will be dressing rooms available the day of your wedding for the members of your wedding party.
- Please know that the color of the paraments and banners hanging in the chancel area will correspond to the season of the church year.
- The altar, pulpit, and baptismal font may not be moved. All these spaces have significance in the life of the church.
- Holy Communion is welcomed and encouraged to be celebrated for all who are gathered for your wedding day.
- Couples are expected to take part in pre-marital counseling with our Pastor and/or another approved counselor.
- Flowers are welcome for your special occasion. If you have flowers, we invite you to leave one bouquet at the church for the Sunday liturgy so the congregation may recognize and affirm your special day.
- Do not tape anything to the church pews or chairs.
- Photography and videography are welcomed for your special day, provided they do not interfere with the wedding liturgy itself. LCHope wants your special day to be captured, so we are pleased to work with your photographer and videographer.
- LCHope's Church Musician has the first right of refusal for all weddings. Guest musicians are welcome to offer an instrumental or vocal solo. All guest musicians must work in coordination with the LCHope Church Musician.
- There is no recorded music allowed during the wedding liturgy.
- Other Clergy are invited to participate with our Pastor for a wedding.

Weddings at LCHope are inclusive - our pastors perform wedding ceremonies for people of all sexual orientations and gender identities.
